Session 3	Third sector, not for profit and private providers	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Third sector interface • Providers – third and independent sectors – all services and all adult client groups • Local area co-ordinators • Housing & registered social landlords
Session 4	Senior managers	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Chief officer of HSCP • Chief social work officer • Joint manager and group managers for LD • Medical director • Nurse director and AHP director / associate director, dependent on structure of LD health services within board
Session 5	Strategic leadership group	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Voting members of IJB • Members of strategic planning group • Public health lead • Executive management team (health and social care) • Chief executives (NHS) and (Council)
Session 6	Commissioners and planners	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Joint planning officers and carer strategy lead • Commissioning team • Procurement officers • Business support staff
<p>Note: There may be opportunity for sessions to be spread across 2 or more groups to ensure that the numbers of staff in groups are manageable and still make contact with relevant staff. This list is not definitive and not all partnerships will have staff members or posts relevant to this list. The partnership may also have sessions which they would like us to observe which have not been listed e.g. meetings or the IJB or equivalent.</p> <p>Depending on the inspection, the lead may also request additional scrutiny sessions if these are needed to triangulate information. Ideally the total number of scrutiny sessions for an inspection should not exceed c.15. However, being rigid about the number of sessions should not override the need to ensure evidence is gathered to an extent that allows for a fair, accurate and balanced report.</p>
